Indoor

Harnesses



- padded waist and legs
- gear loops
- automatic "double-back" buckle
- chalk bag loop at back

Shoes



- Tight, but not too tight (I like old rentals)
- Velcro slippers for indoor or short routes

Chalk Bag



- any cool looking one with small carabiner to clip onto back of harness or use a clip belt
- fill chalk bag ball with loose white chalk
- cheap at gear swaps

Dynamic Rope



- 9 + mm
- 60 meters
- dry sheath
- 2 separate patterns for each half of rope (easy to find center)

Quickdraws



12 will be sufficient for most outdoor routes (or share 6 with your buddy)

- 1 (for belay device)
- 4 more if you want to use for anchors with slings (or you can use 2 quickdraws if the route is short)

ATC-XP

- **Gri-Gri**
- ATC-XP great for lead climbing, ridges for more friction, can singlerope rappel
- Gri-Gri great for beginners or if climbing partner is heavy or takes along time on climbs (kids)
